

CREED HISTORY

The only information that National FCCLA Headquarters could give concerning the creed is listed below:

Adoption Date--don't know

Author--a group of Future Homemakers of America people wrote down what they thought the creed should say, and it was sent to a professional author.

Revision--At national meeting in July, 1986 the voting delegates voted to add "We are members of FHA and HERO chapters." This line was inserted between the lines of the 1st and last paragraphs. The line was added to include HERO chapters in the creed.

Revision-- At national meeting in July, 1999 the voting delegates voted to change the name of the organization from Future Homemakers of America to Family Career and Community Leaders of America. The creed also was changed to reflect the name change and dropped the line "We are members of FHA & HERO chapters."

According to the rules, the participant does not have to give an introduction. Points will not be deducted if a participant chooses not to do an introduction.
