When should I take the ACT?

It's best to take the ACT for the first time as a junior. You've probably completed the coursework corresponding to the test material, and you can use your results to plan for your future. Also, taking the ACT as a junior gives you more time to retest if you'd like to. If you're retaking the ACT as a senior, you should take one of the fall exams to ensure that your test scores are sent to schools by priority application due dates.

When is the ACT?

There are five remaining test dates in this academic year.

Test Date	Registration Deadline	Late Registration (late fee)
October 25, 2008	September 19, 2008	September 20 – October 3
December 13, 2008	November 7, 2008	November 8 – November 20
February 7, 2009	January 6, 2009	January 7 – January 16
April 4, 2009	February 27, 2009	February 28 – March 13
June 13, 2009	May 8, 2009	May 9 – May 22

*The December 13th and February 7th exams are offered at Salisbury High School.
The October 25, Dec 13th, Feb 7th and Apr 4th are offered in Marceline.*

How do I register?

You may register in two ways. Either pick up a paper registration packet or register online. Registration packets and Online Registration flyers are outside Mr. Jarboe's office. Register online at www.actstudent.org. **Your high school code is 261755.** You will need this for registration!

How can I prepare for the ACT?
