

## College Preparatory Studies Certificate Requirements Transition Recommendation

### Seniors graduating 2008:

1. Student must earn at least 3 math credits.
2. At least one of the student's science credits must be for a lab course, such as biology or chemistry.
3. At least three of the student's electives must be from foreign language, English, mathematics, social studies, science, and/or fine arts. Two credits of foreign language are highly recommended.
4. Student must maintain a grade 12 attendance rate of at least 95 percent.
5. The student must earn at least a 3.0 GPA in the combined subject areas of English, mathematics, science, and social studies.
6. The student must score above the prior year's national composite average mean on the ACT or SAT. This criterion will fluctuate annually.

### Seniors graduating 2009:

1. Student must earn at least 3 math credits.
2. Student must earn at least 3 science credits.
3. At least one of the student's science credits must be for a lab course, such as biology or chemistry.
4. At least three of the student's electives must be from foreign language, English, mathematics, social studies, science, and/or fine arts. Two credits of foreign language are highly recommended.
5. Student must maintain a grades 11-12 attendance rate of at least 95 percent.
6. The student must earn at least a 3.0 GPA in the combined subject areas of English, mathematics, science, and social studies.
7. The student must score above the prior year's national composite average mean on the ACT or SAT. This criterion will fluctuate annually.

### Seniors graduating 2010:

1. Student must earn at least 4 math credits.
2. At least one of the student's science credits must be for a lab course, such as biology or chemistry.
3. At least three of the student's electives must be from foreign language, English, mathematics, social studies, science, and/or fine arts. Two credits of foreign language are highly recommended.
4. The student must maintain a 9-12 attendance rate of at least 95 percent.\*
5. The student must earn at least a 3.0 GPA in the combined subject areas of English, mathematics, science, and social studies.
6. The student must score above the prior year's national composite average mean on the ACT or SAT. This criterion will fluctuate annually.

\* The attendance rate requirement had to be increased by two school years for seniors graduating in 2010, as they must have a 95% attendance rate for grades 9-12 in 2010.
