1. Urban Flight and Rural Needs April 15, 2009

Award: Cost of Eligible Tuition and Fees for up to 4 years

Qualifications: US Citizen  
Resident of Missouri  
High school senior or college student at a community college or University  
High School student with 2.5 GPA  
Or College student 30 hours with 2.5 GPA  
Individual with baccalaureate degree returning to teacher ed program

To apply: Submit application to Urban Flight and Rural Needs Scholarship

Deadline: April 15, 2009

2. Robert C. Byrd Honors Scholarship April 15, 2009

Award: Up to \$1500 per year, renewable for up to 4 years

Qualifications:

- Be a resident of Missouri and attend a high school in the state of Missouri
- Be accepted by the fall of the year following high school graduation for enrollment at a four-year institution of higher education as defined in *Institution Eligibility Requirements* (Section 600.4)
- Score in the top 10 percent of the national percentile on the ACT
- Rank in the top 10 percent of your high school graduating class (or top ten percent of the GED rankings)
- File a statement of registration status certifying that you are registered with the selective service or that, for a specific reason, you are not required to be registered.

**3. The 2008-2009 NFIB Young Entrepreneur Awards**

**What are the NFIB Young Entrepreneur Awards?**

- Minimum 400 scholarships nationwide.
- Values range from \$1,000-\$10,000.
- Scholarship to be used for educational expenses at a 2- to 4-year college or university or career/vocational program.
- Applicants must demonstrate entrepreneurial spirit.

Financial need is not a factor.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

High school seniors entering their freshman year for the full 2009-2010 academic year.

Applicants must demonstrate entrepreneurial spirit, including but not limited to:

○ Starting a small business.

Pet sitting or Dog walking, Skate board/snow board shop, computer repair, eBay-based business, jewelry, landscaping/lawn-care, clothing design, agriculture-based business, DJ, car detailing, etc.

○ Participation in organizations such as DECA, FBLA, Junior Achievement and The National Foundation for Teaching Entrepreneurship, among others.

○ Working part-time at a family-owned or other small business.

**Application Process:** Applicants will participate in a 2-phase process. The phase one portion involves identifying 1,500 semi-finalists from the applicant pool. After notification of selection as a semi-finalist, applicants enter phase two and will be required to submit an essay, high school transcript and the nomination of an NFIB member by an identified deadline.

**First Application Dates:** November 2008-January 2009

**Second Application Dates:** February-March 2009

**How are the applicants selected?** The NFIB Young Entrepreneur Award program is administered by Scholarship Program Administrators, Inc., a firm that specializes in administering scholarship programs. This assures complete impartiality in the selection of recipients and maintains a high level of professionalism in dealing with students, parents, high schools and colleges. An independent selection committee, comprised of educators and small business leaders, will be responsible for selecting the scholarship recipients. The selection committee will consider the applicants' academic records, extracurricular activities, leadership, and character. Evidence of entrepreneurial spirit and initiative will be heavily weighted.

4. National Defense Transportation Association Scholarship

Awards: A minimum of 4 scholarships of \$2000-2500 each in 2009

Eligibility: 1. High School Students must reside in Illinois or Missouri.

1. Must be high school seniors graduating in the spring of 2008.

2. College students may be enrolled in any field of study but priority will be given to those enrolling in a degree program related to business, transportation logistics, or physical distribution.

3. Community colleges in which the applicants plans to enroll must offer a four year transfer program.

2. ACT scores
3. Two (2) written recommendations, one of which must be from a high school faculty or staff member
4. An essay that tells how your chosen field of study will contribute to the fields of transportation and logistics.
5. A completed and signed application form
6. An interview with the student may be requested

**31. Moberly Area Community College Superintendent's Scholarship April 10, 2009**

Award: 2 \$ 300 renewable for 3 consecutive semesters

Requirement:

- Nominees must have at least a 2.50 grade point average on a 4.0 scale
- Must enroll in and maintain a minimum of 12 credit hours this fall
- Scholarship is renewable for 3 consecutive semesters providing the recipient earns a minimum of 12 credit hours at MACC and maintains a cumulative 3.0 gpa out of a possible 4
