STUDENT FORMS

All forms must be turned in to your 1st hour teacher by **Friday, August 21**. Students will NOT be allowed to use the school's technology until ALL forms are completed and turned in. KidGuard Insurance forms are due Tuesday, September 1, 2009.

MORNING GUIDELINES

1. One trip to locker until 8:05 bell.
2. No sitting on concession stand area.
3. No one is permitted to enter or exit lobby doors.
4. Do not go any further than Mrs. Koenig's room in the Jr. High hall or the FACS room in the High School hall unless supervised by an instructor.
5. Sodas/Juices are only allowed in the lobby area.
6. All other school guidelines and policies are in effect.

STUDENTS USING THE PHONE

Students may use the phone in the hall across from the office before school and after school. Dial 9 for an outside line. Long distance calls may only be made with a calling card. Students may use the phone in the office ONLY with permission from Mr. Jackson.

MEALS

Money for breakfast & lunch must be placed in the money box in the hall across from the office by 10:00 am. Please check your meal accounts often and deposit if necessary. Meal accounts should NEVER have a negative balance. Money envelopes are in a slot at the end of the hall and on the table in the office. The meal prices this year are as follows: breakfast \$1.10, lunch \$1.50, reduced price breakfast \$0.30, reduced price lunch \$0.40, extra juice \$0.25, extra milk \$0.30.

All students are required to have a meal card. New cards may be purchased in the office for \$2.00. If you do not have your card at breakfast, you have to wait until 7:55 to eat. If you go through the line without your card, you will be required to eat at the front table. If you do not have your card at lunch, you will be required to go to the end of the lunch line. If you go through the line without your card, you will be required to eat at the front table.

LOCKS

Combination locks are available in the office for any student wanting a lock on their hall locker. You may NOT bring a lock from home. Students will be responsible for returning the locks at the end of the year. The cost will be \$6.00 if it is lost.

SODA/VENDING MACHINES

Vending machines in the Lobby are on before school, during lunch, and after school. They are off during class time.

STUDENT PARKING

Student parking forms are available in the office. Parking spaces will be assigned by grade level. Turn in completed forms to the office and a parking space will be assigned by Mr. Jackson.

VO-TECH

Vo-tech classes will begin on Thursday, August 20. Students must sign out on the sheet in the office before boarding the bus and must sign back in upon arrival to school. Other students are not allowed to sign in/out for you. Failure to sign in/out will result in a tardy.
